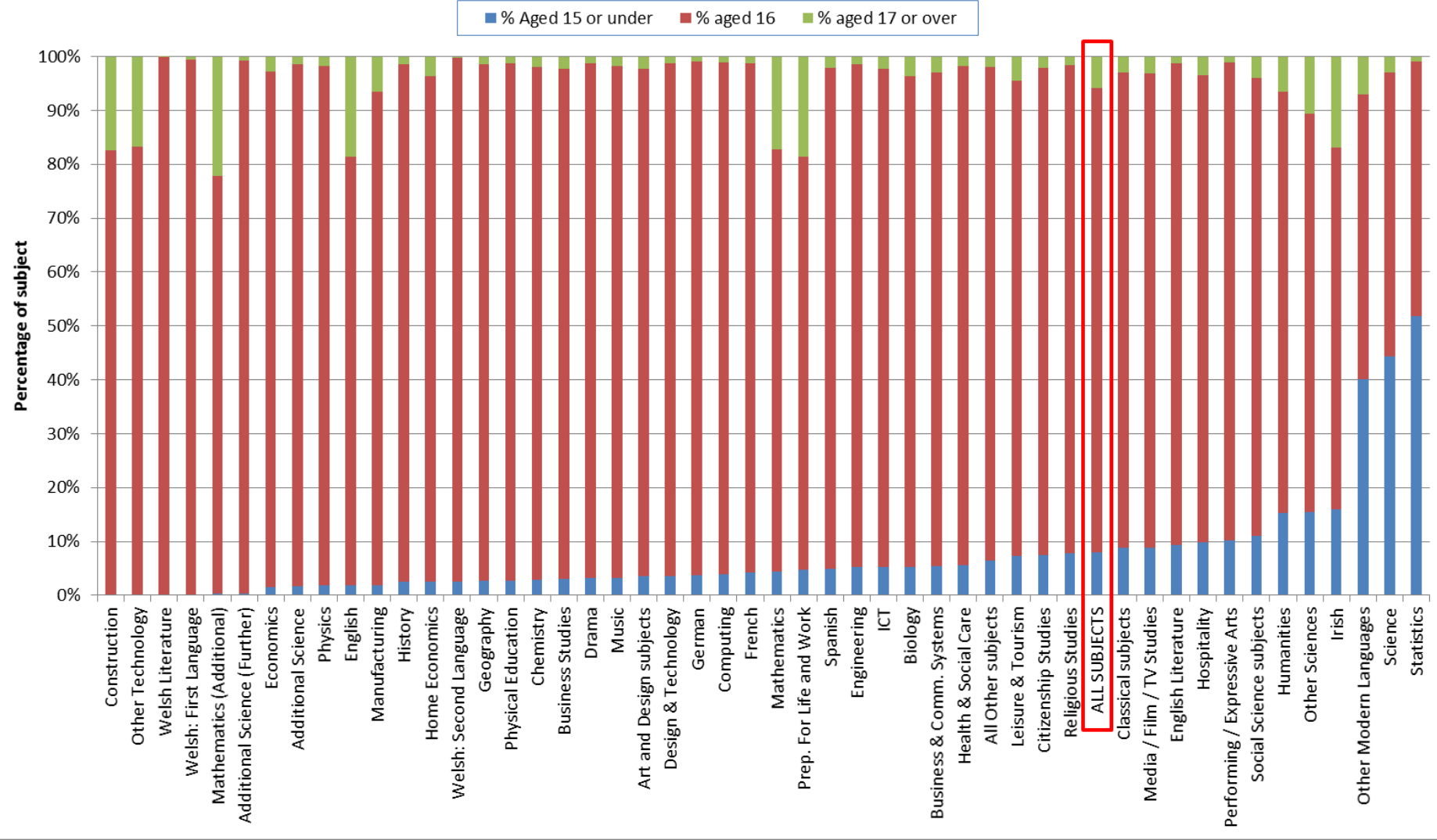


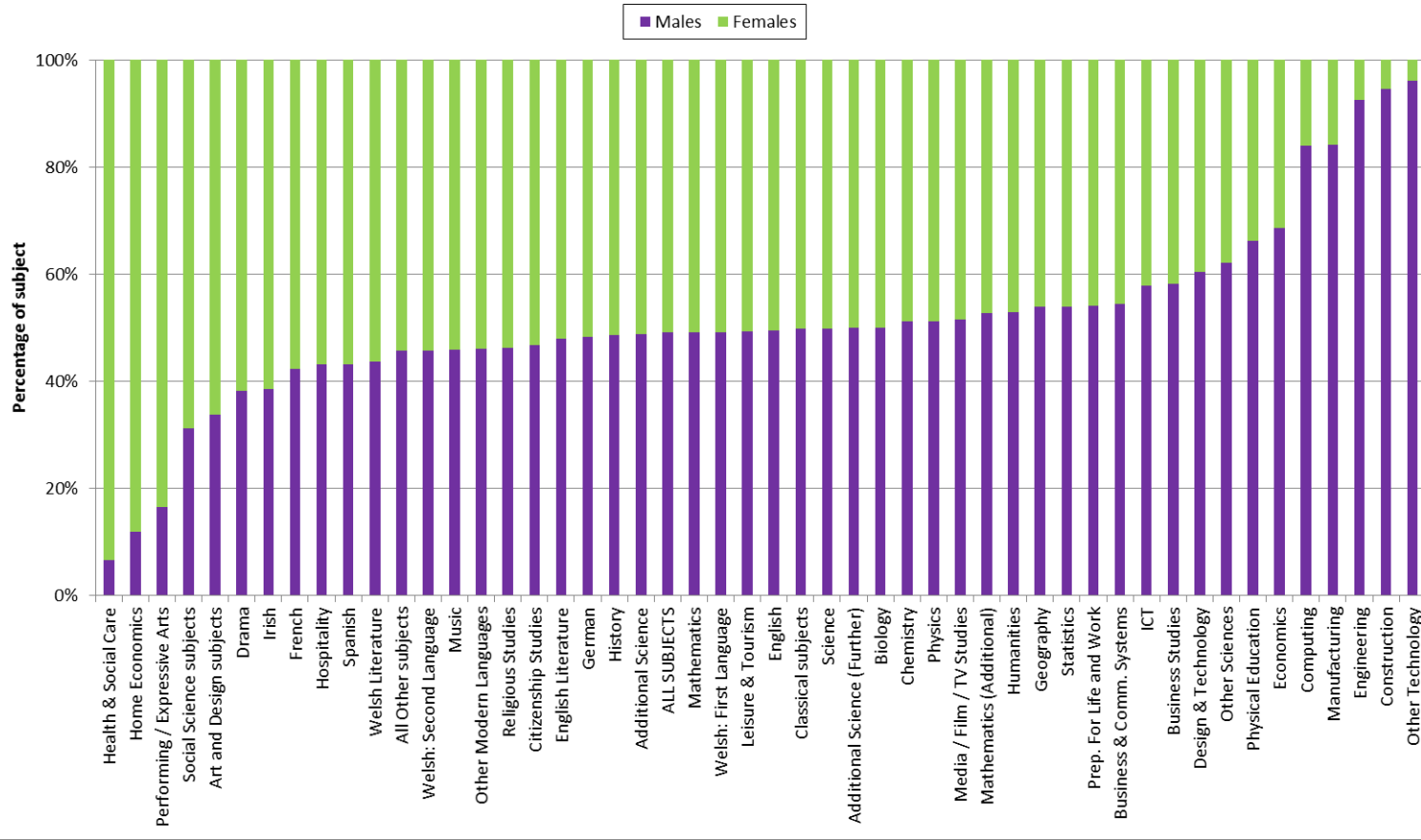

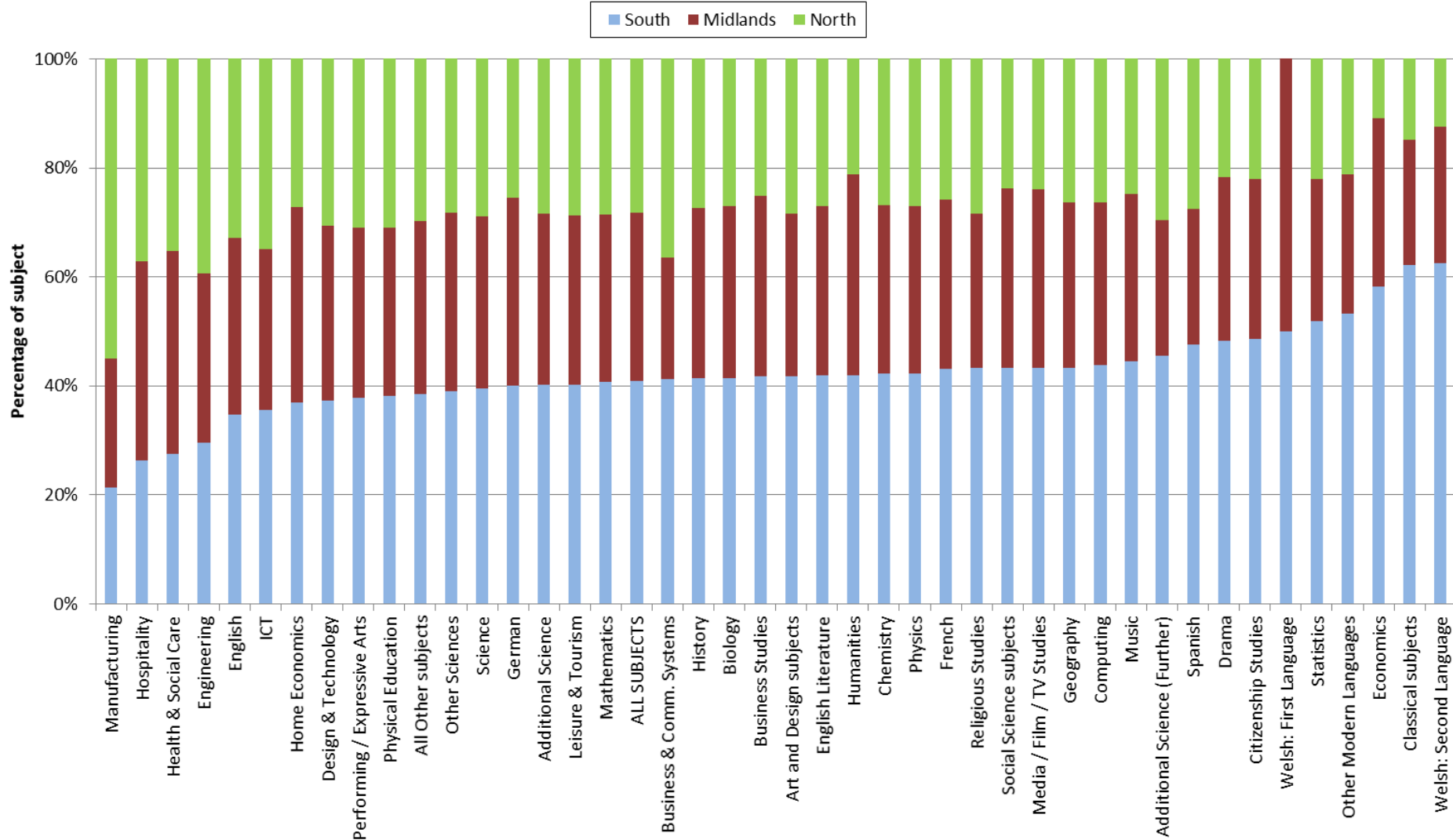
## Age distribution of GCSE entries by subject
